Remembrance Day Contest 2024

Congratulations to VK7 for winning this year's Remembrance Day contest. 42 percent of VK7 participants submitted a log followed by VK6 with 37 percent. Excellent support by the state's operators.

Only one record was broken by VK7TW in the SOMX category with 1298 points.

Other winners were VK7ZBX SOPH, VK2GR SOCW, VK3KK QRP PH, VK3ACU QRP CW, VK2R QRP MX, VK7CMS MS, and VL4R MM.

Best team result was from TOTWOO, VK7TO VK7TW and VK7OO with combined points equalling 2625. Best rookie was Dan VK4DNO with 140 points for the SOPH category.

Log submission overall was 19 percent, down from 23 percent last year. Approximately 1033 participated with 195 logs submitted, including four paper logs. A total of 28,660 QSO's filled the logs submitted with an average score of 222. To summarise there were less logs, more log content and more total operators compared to last year. A total of 16 club stations submitted logs. Email responses to users submitting logs via vklogchecker has ceased due to costs involved. Submitters are notified on screen of successful submission or mistakes needing fixing during the process.

It was obvious that attention to detail was missing when submitting logs and a failure to read the rules for guidance in submitting a Cabrillo V3 log. Luckily our filters applied during submission stopped 19 logs from being submitted as mixed mode, when in fact they were phone logs. 179 submissions were rejected with the reason why and the fix displayed for the operator. Reasons for rejection ranged from incorrect header information and / or invalid QSO lines missing needed information. Of the total rejections, many retries by the same operator were attempted till the problems were fixed. Remember that ADIF text files ARE NOT Cabrillo. They are completely different formats. ADIF does not contain needed contest information therefor using ADIF to Cabrillo converters is also useless.

Please note: The OPERATOR: field in the Cabrillo header saw many rejections and asked for non-contest calls to be used in this field. For those who did not know what a non-contest callsign is, it's your normal everyday assigned call. Our Contest Champion points manager, Peter VK2PR, like any of us, can no longer look up callsigns to tie together a contest call, a normal call, and a name. The filtering of the operators field is now necessary to keep uniformity so that only one callsign is used in the Contest Champion table on the WIA website. Callsigns of individuals and multi-operator station operators in the operators field is used to calculate contest champion points.
